This document constitutes an agreement made between the student, parents, teachers, and the University of Missouri. By signing this document, you agree that you understand and will comply with all of the following criteria set by the University of Missouri:

- Please make sure there are no identifying marks other than the title of the composition on the submitted score or recording. Do not put the name of the composer(s) or school on the score or recording.
- 2. Only <u>five submissions per category per school</u> are allowed to be submitted. It is the responsibility of the school's music teacher(s) to decide which five pieces per category will be entered into the competition.
- 3. Compositions written while at the Mizzou Summer Composition Institute are ineligible to win this competition.
- 4. Conflicts of Interest: While adjudication of all applications is anonymous, we wish to avoid any appearance of impropriety; therefore, compositions written by children of Mizzou faculty or staff <u>are eligible to win</u> but <u>ineligible to receive cash prizes</u>. Associated school music programs <u>are</u> still eligible receive monetary prizes.
- 5. If selected as a winner, the student will attend the COMP Festival at the University of Missouri on April 18, 2026.
