

Graduate Research Assistantship in Audio Recording



he MU School of Music offers graduate assistantships to qualified master of music and doctoral students. The Audio Recording research assistantship is a quarter-time appointment (10hrs per week) with an anticipated stipend of \$9,089 (Masters) or \$9,996 (Doctoral). This amount is paid to students over the nine months of the academic year.

In addition, tuition for coursework required for the degree is waived during the appointment period. This waiver covers both Missouri residents and non-residents at all levels. The latest information on tuition and fees may be found at https://cashiers.missouri.edu/cost/.

Quarter-time assistantships come with a **50%** allowance for health insurance.

Applicants may qualify for assistantships in other areas as well. Please email the School of Music (<u>music@missouri.edu</u>) for available assistantships.

Duties may include

Managing, production, and recording of School of Music events, cataloging and maintaining inventory of sound and video equipment, maintaining the archive of Mizzou School of Music recordings and the School of Music YouTube channel, and other miscellaneous audiovisual assistance as needed.
