

# Graduate Teaching Assistantship in Composition



he MU School of Music offers graduate assistantships to qualified master of music and doctoral students. The Composition teaching assistantship is a half-time appointment (20hrs per week) with an anticipated stipend of \$17,820 (Masters) - \$19,600 (Doctoral). This amount is paid to students over the nine months of the academic year.

In addition, tuition for coursework required for the degree is waived during the appointment period. This waiver covers both Missouri residents and non-residents at all levels. Half-time assistantships also come with **full health insurance coverage.**

Administrative support to the Managing Director of the Mizzou New Music Initiative (MNMI) and composition faculty. This may include the administration of the Creating Original Music Project (COMP), an outreach program directed at composers in grades K-12, teaching, or assisting with other applicable administrative tasks.
