

Graduate Teaching Assistantship in Composition



he MU School of Music offers graduate assistantships to qualified master of music students. The **Composition** teaching assistantship is a half-time appointment **(20 hrs per week)** with an anticipated stipend of **\$18,177**. This amount is paid to students over the nine months of the academic year.

In addition, tuition for coursework required for the degree is waived during the appointment period. This waiver covers both Missouri residents and non-residents at all levels. The latest information on tuition and fees may be found at https://cashiers.missouri.edu.

Half-time assistantships also come with **full** health insurance coverage.

Applicants may qualify for assistantships in other areas as well. Please email the School of Music (<u>music@missouri.edu</u>) for available assistantships.

Duties may include

Teaching and administrative support to the Managing Director of the Mizzou New Music Initiative (MNMI) and composition faculty, including the administration of the Creating Original Music Project (COMP), an outreach program directed at composers in grades K-12.
